

## **Education Programs Volunteer**

Do you have a love for marine life? Do you have a passion for teaching about what you love? This is the perfect volunteer position for you! Marine CSI is looking for several people who can dedicate their time to assist with our Watershed Walkabout program education.

Our Watershed Walkabout program has been running since the inception of Marine CSI and now in its sixth year, has reached students in K-12<sup>th</sup> grade from Onslow County south to Brunswick County. As plans to increase reach push us further west to Columbus and Duplin Counties, and our program continues to gain momentum, we are in need of extra hands.

As an **Education Programs Volunteer**, you will assist our Director of Education during our inschool field trips in all four counties we serve. As you learn the individual activities, you will be able to lead programs on your own. Marine CSI provides most of the materials for each activity, along with training, shadowing, and evaluations you will need for this position.

## A Day in the Life of an Education Programs Volunteer:

As an **Education Programs Volunteer**, you are representing Marine CSI from the moment you step into a school to the moment you leave. Each program is specifically designed to teach an entire grade throughout the day, with rotations to each classroom for approximately one hour at a time.

- Arrive at school and check in with main office
- Set up in first class on the provided schedule
- Follow rotation schedule throughout the day, including lunch and breaks
- Check out with main office (don't forget the check!)

We ask for a full-day commitment to our Watershed Walkabout program (typically 6-7 hours), especially with the option to lead programs on your own, since the coordination of these is done through the teachers' schedules. If a half-day is needed, we can accommodate, but would prefer mornings to assist with activities. No half-day commitment will be accommodated for leading full-day programs.
