

## **Community Engagement Volunteer**

Do you have a love for marine life? Do you have a passion for teaching about what you love? This is the perfect volunteer position for you! Marine CSI is looking for several people who can dedicate their time to assist with our community engagement.

Our **Watershed Walkabout program** has been running since the inception of Marine CSI and now in its sixth year, has reached students in K-12<sup>th</sup> grade from Onslow County south to Brunswick County. As we expand our reach into the community, we have offered adapted activities to Girl Scout troops, homeschools, and summer camps. As the need for these programs continues gaining momentum with these groups, we are in need of extra hands.

As a **Community Engagement Volunteer**, you will assist our Director of Education during our on-site programs in all four counties we serve. These programs tend to run outside the normal public school times, as Girl Scout troops can meet during the week in the evenings, and camps run throughout the summer months. As you learn the individual activities, you will be able to lead programs on your own. Marine CSI provides most of the materials for each activity, along with training, shadowing, and evaluations you will need for this position.

As part of our continued reach throughout these four counties and beyond, we also participate in several events throughout the year. These events require 4-6 hours of commitment to be at our booth. Table activities include providing a small activity for kids and speaking about our programs on our behalf.

We ask for a varied and flexible commitment as a **Community Engagement Volunteer**, as these opportunities range from during the day, evening, or weekends. Some programs will last an hour, while some could be several hours long, depending on the requests of the group. No half-day commitment will be available for leading full-day programs.
